This letter is to serve as an informal notification for both the Johnson City Field office and Nashville offices that the property at 1450 Lincoln Street Kingsport, TN (former Heritage Glass Plant) has changed ownership. As of November 2019 the property has officially changed hands from KIDB to Eastman Chemical Company. However, KIDB is still monitoring the storm water outfalls through Appalachian Environmental Resources, Inc., and will continue to do so until TDEC directs otherwise for the changeover of ownership and permit (TNR050866).

The glass cullet cleanup will be conducted by Eastman Chemical Company. Marsha Edward of Eastman's Environmental Division should be the future contact for the property. Currently I am working directly with W.C. Wetherholt, Manager of Capital Planning & Real Estate (wcw@eastman.com).

Bryan would you please advise if we need to file a NPDES Transfer of Ownership or Notice of Termination (NOT) Storm Water Discharges or if Eastman needs to file the Transfer of Ownership.
