**Application of Pesticides NPDES General Permit (PGP)  
Notice of Coverage Fact Sheet**

The Division of Water Resources received from your company a Notice of Intent (NOI) to be covered under the Tennessee General NPDES Permit for Discharges from Application of Pesticides (PGP). The new PGP became effective on May 1, 2022, and expires on April 30, 2027. **We have are hereby notifying you that your activities are covered under this general permit.**

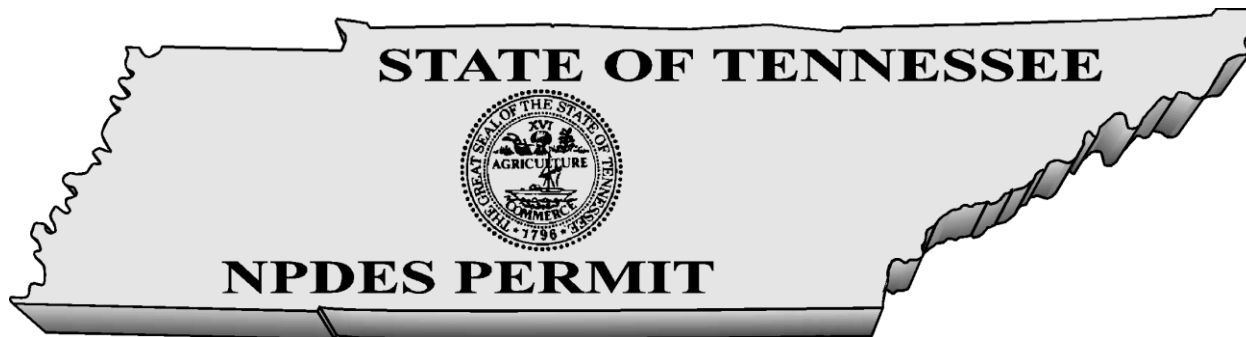

Notice of Coverage under the General NPDES Permit for  
**DISCHARGES ASSOCIATED WITH  
APPLICATION OF PESTICIDES (PGP)**

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Under authority of the Tennessee Water Quality Control Act of 1977 (T.C.A. 69-3-101 et seq.) and the delegation of authority from the United States Environmental Protection Agency under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended by the Clean Water Act of 1977 (33 U.S.C. 1251, et seq.):

Discharger: **Shelby County Health Department**

is authorized to discharge: **pesticides and pesticide degradation products from one or more of the following use patterns: (1) mosquito and other flying insect pest control; (2) weed and algae control; (3) animal pest control; or (4) forest canopy pest control**

to receiving waters named: **all waters of the state within the Pest Management Area as described on the Notice of Intent (NOI)**

in accordance with effluent limitations, monitoring requirements and other conditions set forth herein.

Coverage under this general permit shall become effective on **May 1, 2022** and shall expire on **April 30, 2027**.

Notice of Coverage Issuance date: **May 1, 2022**
