PROJECT DESCRIPTION / PURPOSE The applicant proposes nine open-cut stream crossings for gravity sewer line up-grades and other utility installations, veg-etation clearing and stream pump-arounds for construction access and trenching, installation of a temporary span bridge and a permanent reinforced concrete pipe re-sulting in eight feet of stream loss for sewer line and equalization basin up-grades. Removal of 20 feet of culvert and associated headwall will offset stream associated headwall will offset stream length loss.

ANTIDEGRADATION

In accordance with the Tennessee Anti-degradation Statement (Rule 0400-40-03-.06), the Division has made the preliminary determination that the proposed activities will not result in an appre-ciable permanent loss of resource values, and therefore will result in no more than de minimis degradation of a waters without mitigation.
