Mr. Newton -

It was nice speaking with you today. As requested, please find a copy of the *Declarations to Nutrient Management Plan* form and color maps attached. Unfortunately, it appears that Giles County has not yet updated their GIS on the State of Tennessee's Real Estate Assessment Data – there is a tax card available for your parcel at 33545 Ardmore Ridge Road; however, your outparcel does not appear to have been added to the tax map. So, the parcel shown on the map attached is likely not accurate – the aerial imagery is old enough that your poultry houses weren't actually built at the time it was taken. If you would, please sketch-in the correct property boundaries. I've also provided a Google map (that shows the poultry houses), which may be easier to use. You only need to label one of the aerial maps, and the topographic map. As mentioned, I'll also need a completed 100% Export Poultry worksheet, a Notice of Intent, and a litter analysis taken within the last 12 months in order to process your application for your permit modification. After approval of your application, it is forwarded to TDEC for a modified permit to be issued. After you've received your permit modification, you may apply for renewal by sending in a new Notice of Intent, and a written statement indicating that you will continue to operate under your current, approved Nutrient Management Plan. Please let me know if you need anything else.






