Division of Water Resources personnel visited your laboratory and performed a microbiology audit on November 7, 2023. We would like to thank you and your staff for the courtesy extended during the audit. We appreciate the effort that is put forth to keep your laboratory and utility in compliance.

### **I. Certification Status**

Alcoa Water Treatment Plant's microbiology certification for Colilert is valid through November 7, 2026; subject to the satisfactory correction of deviations and continued compliance with the State of Tennessee certification criteria and the USEPA laboratory certification criteria and procedures for quality assurance (Manual for the Certification of Laboratories Analyzing Drinking Water, Fifth Edition, 2005).

#### II. Deviations

The Collect reference comparator was expired during the inspection. Every effort should be made to ensure that it is replaced before it expires. (EPA Certification Manual, Chapter 5, Section 5.3.1.10)

Documentation showing that a new comparator has been purchased and received has already been submitted. No further documentation is needed at this time.

#### III. Remarks

- Continue building training folders for each employee that is involved with the laboratory. They should include documentation of all training and testing that shows competency in analyzing bacteriological samples. This can include classes that are taken for operator continuing education credits taught by Fleming Training Center or TAUD if they pertain to the laboratory. (EPA Certification Manual, Chapter 5, Section 1.4)
- 2. The Quality Assurance was reviewed during the inspection. It is very well written and should be followed in the daily operation of the laboratory. It should be reviewed annually and revised as needed. (EPA Certification Manual, Chapter 5, Section 7.1)
