### **Tennessee Multi-Sector Permit (TMSP) Notice of Coverage Fact Sheet**

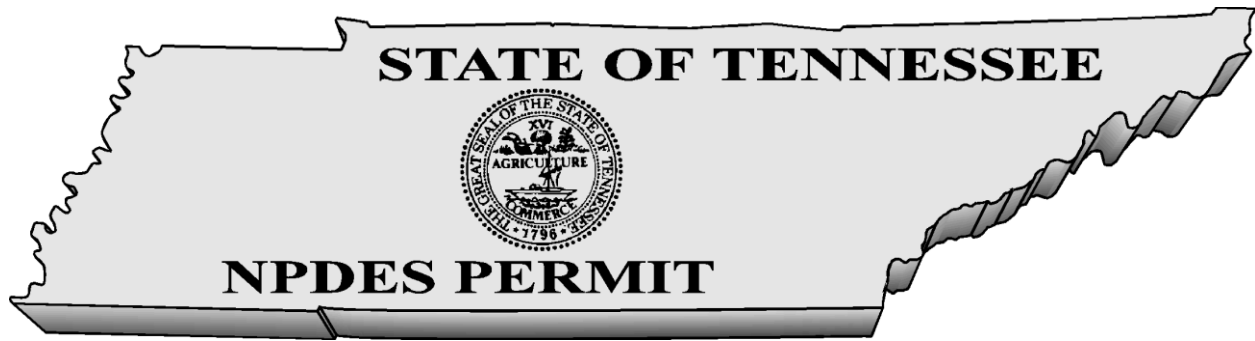
The new TMSP became effective on July 1, 2022, and expires on June 30, 2025. **We are hereby notifying you that your facility is covered under this general permit.**

Enclosed with this fact sheet you will find a Notice of Coverage (NOC) with the permit tracking number, facility's name, address, receiving stream information and the industry-specific sector(s) that apply to your facility. We will provide you with a printed copy of the TMSP only upon your request.

Under authority of the Tennessee Water Quality Control Act of 1977 (T.C.A. 69-3-101 et seq.) and the delegation of authority from the United States Environmental Protection Agency under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended by the Clean Water Act of 1977 (33 U.S.C. 1251, et seq.):

Discharger: **3M Technical Ceramics**  
is authorized to discharge: **Storm water associated with industrial activity**
