Subject: Additional Testing at McNairy Loves SOP 16009

Dear Mr. Harris:

On March 22, 2018 we had a high BOD reading of 189 mg/L at our Loves plant. You requested we start testing water quality twice a month and we agreed. At the conclusion of 2018, our BOD average was 27.1. For the year 2019, our BOD average was 25.8 Thus far this year, our average has been 23.22. In the past, the information these tests gave us was helpful. For quite a while now we have depended on our own non EPA approved test run onsite. Waiting for test results, sometimes a week or more just did not allow us to make the adjustments needed. Though we plan on to continue running our process testing, we will not be able to report it on our reports. I am requesting we return to the original testing requirements of our permit, it has been three years since the high BOD reading. Additionally, please consider that fixed film technology trickling filter takes some time to establish microbes so a high early BOD would not be that unusual. The additional testing is also a large cost for the utility. The inspection on 6/18/20 seemed to go very well.

I look forward to hearing from you on this matter.
