The Division of Water Resources received from your company a Notice of Intent (NOI) to be covered under the General NPDES Permit for Discharges of Storm Water Runoff and Process Wastewater Associated with Ready Mixed Concrete Facilities (RMCP). The new RMCP general permit was issued on October 31, 2022, with an effective date of November 1, 2022, and an expiration date of October 31, 2027. We have recorded your facility's information and are hereby notifying you that your facility is covered under this RMCP general permit.

Enclosed with this fact sheet you will find a Notice of Coverage with the permit tracking number, facility's name and address, receiving stream information, and other site-specific information that applies to your facility. Please remember that all off-site washout locations require written approval of the property owner and notification to the local Field Office. In order to get a copy of the RMCP general permit we ask you to visit TDEC's <u>Dataviewer</u>. We will provide you with a printed copy of the RMCP general permit **only** upon your request.
