Dear Mr. Hajiani:

Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control staff conducted a file review and discovered either form APC 202, or forms APC 100 and APC 114, has not been submitted for **Hasnabad Properties LLC** located at **2655 Lake City Hwy Clinton, TN 37716**.

Effective August 15, 2017, the Division implemented Permit-by-Rule for gasoline dispensing facilities. You may now submit Notice of Intent form APC 202 for authorization under Permit-by-Rule. Once approved, the Division will issue a Notice of Authorization to your facility, confirming authorization to operate a minor air contaminant source under Permit-by-Rule. The Notice of Authorization does not have an expiration date or application fee, and takes the place of an operating permit that was previously written for gasoline dispensing facilities.

Form APC 202, or forms APC 100 and APC 114, must be submitted to the Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this letter. These forms may be submitted via email to Air.Pollution.Control@TN.gov. Forms submitted via email must be signed, dated, and in PDF format. However, if preferred, paper forms can be mailed to the

Technical Secretary at the address included on the forms. Please include Emission Source Reference Number **01-0213** on the form(s).

Please be advised forms APC 202, APC 100, and APC 114 cannot be submitted for gasoline dispensing facilities located in the following counties: Knox, Hamilton, Davidson, and Shelby. Contact information for these local air programs can be found by visiting: <https://www.tn.gov/environment/environmental-related-contacts.html>

For all other counties in Tennessee, form APC 202, or forms APC 100 and 114, must be submitted for each gasoline dispensing facility you own or operate.

If assistance is needed, the Small Business Environmental Assistance Program is a free, confidential, technical program within TDEC that can help. Should you fail to submit the required forms to the Division, as discussed herein, you will be in violation of the Tennessee Code Annotated (Tenn. Code Ann.), specifically, Tenn. Code Ann. 68-201-105(b)(2), which gives the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) authority to:

[r]equire that any person furnish the department information required by it in discharge of its duties under this part, if the department has reason to believe such person is, or may be about to, causing or contributing to air pollution[.]

Upon receipt of your information, the Division will determine if additional enforcement action may be taken.
