The application has been submitted below and is subject to an Aquatic Resource Assessment Permit under the Tennessee Water Control Act of 1977, T.C.A. §6-1-101 et seq. In addition, federal permits may be required from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the Tennessee Valley Authority under the Clean Water Act and §24 of the Tennessee Valley Authority Act, respectively. Section 401 of the Clean Water Act requires a state to issue a water quality certification from the state when a federal permit is required. This notice may cover applications subject to both.

The proposal is invited to submit written comments to the department. Written comments must be received within thirty days of the date that this notice is posted. Comments will become part of the record and will be considered in the final decision. The applicant's name and application number should be referenced in all comments.

The permit application, including documentation such as detailed plans and maps, and related comments are available at the department's address above or online (link above) for review and/or copying or mailing to: TDEC website at <http://tdec.tn.gov>.

To file a hearing request with the department, indicate the interest of the person requesting it, the reasons that the hearing is warranted, and the water quality issues that have raised. When there is sufficient public interest in water quality issues, the department shall hold a public hearing in accordance with 0400-40-07-.04(4)(f). In deciding whether to issue or deny a permit, the department will consider all comments of record and the requirements of the federal and state laws. In making this decision, a determination will be made regarding the best use of the resource and the value of any proposed mitigation. The department shall consider practicable alternatives to the action proposed. The department shall also consider loss of waters or habitat, diminishment in biological diversity, cumulative or secondary impacts to water bodies, and adverse impact to unique, high quality, or impaired waters.

The Site was formerly used and operated by Sealed Air Corporation, formerly JohnsonDiversify, Inc., and was transferred to Auto-C, LLC, by Auto-C, LLC, by Auto-C, LLC. The Board acknowledges that the Site has been impacted by past industrial and commercial activities, and the residuals of historical groundwater service station operations. Soil and Groundwater were contaminated at the Site with petroleum hydrocarbons from gasoline servicing and dispensing operations. There is no evidence that the Petroleum Hydrocarbon contamination poses a threat to the Site. Remedial Action with regard to the Site is being overseen by the Tennessee Division of Remediation. All rights to the implementation and remediation of the Site are on file with the Tennessee Division of Remediation. The Voluntary Party proposes to use the subject property for industrial, commercial and retail purposes. This will include using an
