### **Tennessee Multi-Sector Permit (TMSP) Notice of Coverage Fact Sheet**

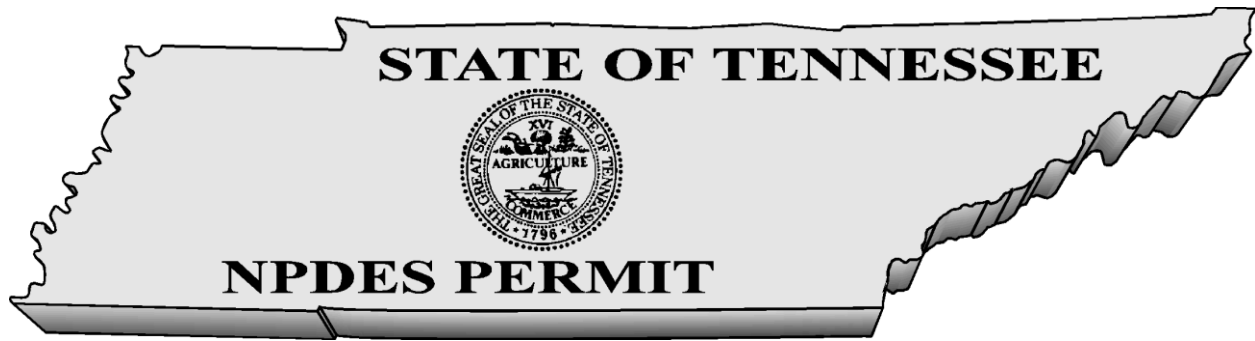
We received from your company a Notice of Intent (NOI) to be covered under the Tennessee Storm Water Multi-Sector Permit (TMSP). The new TMSP became effective on July 2020, and expires on June 30, 2022. **We are hereby notifying you that your facility is covered under this general permit. The facility's SWPPP shall be modified to address additional requirements in the new permit no later than 60 days following the effective date of this permit.**

Enclosed with this fact sheet you will find a Notice of Coverage with the permit tracking number, facility's name, address, receiving stream information and the industry-specific sector(s) that apply to your facility. Under authority of the Tennessee Water Quality Control Act of 1977 (T.C.A. 69-3-101 et seq.) and the delegation of authority from the United States Environmental Protection Agency under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended by the Clean Water Act of 1977 (33 U.S.C. 1251, et seq.):

Discharger: **45 Auto & Truck Salvage**  
is authorized to discharge: **Storm water associated with industrial activity**
