This letter is to inform you the Division of Water Resources (division) is terminating the above referenced permit coverage effective as of the date of this letter. As stated in your letter, the property at 1450 Lincoln Street has been sold to another person.

Please note that all storm water discharges associated with activity require an NPDES storm water permit from the division. Therefore, if you should decide to again discharge, you should submit an NOI in accordance with the requirements of the NPDES at least 30 days prior to the starting of any activities.
