Notice of Coverage (NOC) under the General NPDES Permit for SMALL MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4)

Under authority of the Tennessee Water Quality Control Act of 1977 (T.C.A. 69-3-101 <u>et seq.</u>) and the delegation of authority from the United States Environmental Protection Agency under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended by the Clean Water Act of 1977 (33 U.S.C. 1251, <u>et seq.</u>) the following operator of a small municipal separate storm sewer system is authorized to discharge stormwater runoff into the waters of the State of Tennessee in accordance with the various eligibility criteria, administrative procedures, program requirements, reporting requirements, etc. set forth in the Tennessee MS4 NPDES general permit.
