GENERAL CONDITIONS

Only septage collected from holding basins, septic tanks and subsurface disposal fields located in Blount County will be accepted. Septage resulting from any industrial process will not be accepted.

A Permit shall be denied, suspended or revoked when the City of Maryville Water and Sewer Department has determined that the operation has been, or will be, conducted in violation of any City, State or Federal regulation and/or law.

Permits shall not be transferable or assignable and shall automatically become invalid upon change of ownership or under suspension or revocation of this Permit.


Permittee shall maintain records, (invoices/manifests), of all transported septage to the City of Maryville Wastewater Treatment System. All records must be available, upon request, for inspection by the City of Maryville.

Permittee has been issued a personalized "swipe" card to activate the septage receiving station. Each time the Permittee's card is swiped; a computer system opens the discharge port, records the Permittee's information, including the company's name, date, time and number of gallons discharged. In the event that the card reader system is out of service, the Permittee or Permittee representative shall report to an operator at the Regional Wastewater Treatment plant and complete the information required on the log for each load prior to discharge at the septage receiving station.

Permittee shall pay the monthly charges assessed by the City of Maryville Water and Sewer as taken from the card reader database records, Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant log, and from visual observations by City of Maryville personnel.

This Permit is conditional upon conformance to the Sewer Use Ordinance of the City of Maryville in effect or as amended from time to time.


Dear Mr. Strickland:
