Dear Mayor Ledbetter,

Cowan's NPDES permit was issued on August 31, 2021 and became effective on February 1, 2022. Part 3.2.a of the NPDES permit requires Cowan to submit to the Division an Industrial Waste Survey (IWS) within 120 days of the effective date of the permit. As of the date of this letter, the Division has not received a submission. This is more than 120 days past the effective date of the permit. The IWS serves as a mechanism to evaluate if Cowan has any industrial sources of wastewater that discharge to the Cowan STP. This letter serves as a reminder that an IWS is required within 120 days of the effective date of the NPDES permit. Please submit an IWS to me at <a href="mailto:Gordon.Holcomb@tn.gov">Gordon.Holcomb@tn.gov</a> by May 4, 2023.
