Dear Mr. Baxter:

This letter is to inform you the Division of Water Resources is administratively inactivating the file record for the above referenced permit effective as of the date of its expiration on October 31, 2015. Division staff have confirmed with Mr. Terry Dockery of your staff via telephone yesterday that operation at the facility, located at 3304 Chestnut Hill Road, no longer intends to discharge the non-contact cooling water or collected spring and well water discharges that were previously regulated by this permit. Mr. Dockery additionally relays that the outfalls have been plugged so that they cannot discharge. If you should decide to discharge again under an individual permit, you must reapply for an appropriate permit at least 180 days prior to any proposed discharge.
