An additional photo was taken February 29, 2024 that shows the surface water from a rain the previous night was directed to the retention pond under the Autocar Dump truck....
The regrade appears to have worked well... even though I cut through the buried phone line.... Spectrum has placed an order to move the phone line out of the regraded area....
