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Description and design capacity of treatment process and facilities. **At Corrective Action System (CAS) #1, extraction of the groundwater is accomplished using dual phase recovery supplemented with air assist. CAS #3 will primarily extract soil vapors from the subsurface. It is possible, however, that a *de minimus* amount of water will be recovered by CAS #3. The extracted water that is directed to CAS #1 and CAS #3 will pass through a 15 gpm oil/water separator, be treated in an air stripper, pass through bag filters and activated carbon, and then will be discharged as a combined effluent.**

Expected starting date for groundwater treatment, and estimated life of remediation project: **CAS1 was started up in December 2016. Tentative start date for CAS3 is 9/30/18. The estimated future life of the remediation project is 5 years.**
