Dear Mayor Leckner,

Adamsville's NPDES permit was issued on June 26, 2023, and became effective on September 1, 2023. Part 3.2.a.ix of the NPDES permit requires Adamsville to submit to the Division a written technical evaluation of the need to revise local limits within 120 days of the effective date of the permit. As of the date of this letter, the Division has not received a submission. This is more than 120 days past the effective date of the permit; therefore, this letter serves as a **Notice of Violation** for failure to submit the required technical evaluation of the need to revise local limits within the required time frame.

Part 3.2.a.viii of the NPDES permit requires Adamsville to submit the results of an updated industrial waste survey (IWS) to the Pretreatment Section of the Division of Water Resources within 120 days of the effective date of the permit. As of the date this letter, the Division has not received a submission. This is more than 120 days past the effective date of the permit; therefore, this letter serves as a **Notice of Violation** for failure to submit the required industrial waste survey within the required time frame.
