This letter is to inform you the Division of Water Resources (the division) intends to terminate the above referenced permit. Also enclosed is a copy of the public notice that announces our intent to terminate this permit. The notice affords the public an opportunity to review the proposed permit action and, if necessary, request a public hearing on this termination process.

If you disagree with the provisions and requirements described in this letter, you have thirty (30) days from the date of this correspondence to notify the division of your objections. If your objections cannot be resolved, you may appeal this permit upon issuance. This appeal should be filed in accordance with Section 69-3-110 of the Tennessee Code Annotated.
