Dear Mr. Iskiwitz:

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, Division of Water Resources' records indicate that the above referenced facility has coverage under the TN Multi Sector Permit (TMSP). The Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) code for this facility determines which Sector of the TMSP the facility must follow. Based on this facility's SIC code, the TMSP Sector(s) requires annual storm water sampling of the storm water runoff from the site.

If you have not already collected a storm water sample for the year 2018 and submitted the results to the Division, this email serves as a courtesy reminder that a storm water sample for the year 2018 is required to be collected prior to the end of the calendar year. The sample results should be submitted to the Division on the Annual Storm Water Monitoring Report form within 30 days of receipt of the sample results to the following address:
