NO EXPOSURE CERTIFICATION FOR EXCLUSION FROM NPDES STORMWATER PERMITTING

Submission of this No Exposure Certification form constitutes notice that the entity identified below does not require authorization for its stormwater discharges associated with industrial activity under an NPDES Individual Permit or the Tennessee Multi-Sector General Permit for Industrial Activity (TMSP) due to the existence of a condition of no exposure. For more information, see instructions or contact your local Environmental Field Office at the toll-free number 1-888-891-8332 (TDEC).

Facility Information table with fields: Name, Address, County, SIC Code(s), TMS Tracking No., Latitude, Longitude, and permit status.

Facility Contact table with fields: Name, Title or Position, Mailing Address, City, State, Zip, Phone Number, and E-mail.

Exposure Checklist table with 11 rows of questions regarding materials and activities exposed to precipitation and runoff.

A condition of no exposure exists at an industrial facility when all industrial materials and activities are protected by a storm resistant shelter to prevent exposure to rain, snow, snowmelt, and/or runoff. Industrial materials or activities include, but are not limited to, material handling equipment or activities, industrial machinery, raw materials, intermediate products, by-products, final products, or waste products. Material handling activities include the storage, loading and unloading, transportation, or conveyance of any raw material, intermediate product, final product or waste product. A storm resistant shelter is not required for the following industrial materials and activities:


- drums, barrels, tanks, and similar containers that are tightly sealed, have clean exteriors, are not deteriorated and do not leak. "Sealed" means banded or otherwise secured and without operational taps or valves;
- clean pallets that are free of residuals;
- adequately maintained vehicles used in material handling; and
- final products, other than products that would be mobilized in stormwater discharges (e.g., rock salt).

A No Exposure Certification form must be submitted for each facility qualifying for the no exposure exclusion, and must be re-submitted **once every five years**. In addition, the exclusion from NPDES permitting is available on a facility-wide basis only, not for individual outfalls. If any industrial activities or materials are or will be exposed to precipitation and/or runoff, the facility is not eligible for the no exposure exclusion. Signing and submitting this No Exposure Certification form certifies that a condition of no exposure exists at its facility or site, and the facility is obligated to comply with the terms and conditions of 40 CFR 122.26(g).

Certification and Signature: (must be signed by president, vice-president or equivalent ranking elected official).

I certify under penalty of law that I have read and understand the eligibility requirements for claiming a condition of no exposure and obtaining an exclusion from NPDES stormwater permitting; and that there are no discharges of stormwater contaminated by exposure to industrial activities or materials from the industrial facility identified in this document (except as allowed under 40 CFR 122.26 (g)(2)). I understand that I am obligated to submit a No Exposure Certification form **once every five years** to the NPDES permitting authority and, if requested, to the operator of the local MS4 into which this facility discharges (where applicable). I understand that I must allow the NPDES permitting authority, or MS4 operator where the discharge is into the local MS4, to perform inspections to confirm the condition of no exposure and to make such inspection reports publicly available upon request. I understand that I must obtain coverage under an NPDES permit if any industrial activities or materials are or will be exposed to precipitation and/or runoff from the facility. I certify under penalty of law that this document and any attachments were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gathered and evaluated the information submitted. Based upon my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly involved in gathering the information, the information submitted is to the best of my knowledge and belief true, accurate and complete. I am aware there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment for knowing violations. As specified in Tennessee Code Annotated Section 39-16-702(a)(4), this declaration is made under penalty of perjury.
