The Division of Water Resources staff wishes to thank you for the generous time and courtesy your staff showed during the recent Pretreatment Technical Assist Visit (TAV) conducted by Mr. Oakley Hall on July 27, 2023, at the City of Sparta, Sewer Treatment Facility in White County. The inspection included discussion and an associated file review.

Program Document Review

Sparta (the Control Authority) currently has two (2) SIUs that are discharging wastewater for treatment to the sewer treatment plant (STP). Additional industrial connections are not expected in the near future. The Pretreatment Program was discussed at length with Mr. Brandon Young (Chief Operator). Mr. Young has established effective communication with the industrial user contacts (THK – Kel Stott and BASF – Michael Akehinmi). Since wastewater treatment staff are relatively new to the pretreatment regulatory requirements, it is strongly recommended that they attend pretreatment training courses, which should include Voluntary Pretreatment Level One (1) certification. This will help them to better understand and implement the pretreatment program. Mr. Brandon Young should be identified as the Sparta Pretreatment Coordinator.

Industrial Permit Review

The two current industrial user permits became effective on December 1, 2021, and will expire on November 30, 2026. Sampling locations are listed in the permit. No violations were noted since the last inspection (PCI). The wastewater treatment facility accepts septage waste from county septic tanks.

File Review Findings

Files were reviewed at the City of Sparta STP. The files and logbooks were found to be in good order. The two industrial users are being inspected annually and sampled by the CA semi-annually. Engineering changes to the discharge at the BASF facility continue to be reviewed by site personnel. Benzene at the BASF discharge has been effectively reduced. No violations for the two (2) SIUs were noted.

Industrial Users

BASF

Records were available for review. The facility manufactures plastic beads (a physical process). There have been no significant changes in the process flow. The facility made some engineering & technology changes with regard to how they move raw materials in the facility. Mr. Young maintains communication with the facility. Last samples collected: February 25, 2023, and June 6, 2023.

THK Rhythm North America

Records were available for review. The facility is a CIU (metal finisher). Automotive suspension parts are manufactured and painted. There have been no significant changes in the process flow. The facility has expanded. The expansion has not changed the industrial characteristics of the wastewater discharge as it is the use of machined aluminum and is not painted. Mr. Young maintains communication with the facility. Samples were collected on December 15, 2022, and March 30, 2023, along with a more recent collection that are not yet on file.
