On July 11, 2023, as representatives of the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, Division of Water Resources, Mr. John Lay and I performed a routine compliance inspection at the above referenced facility to evaluate compliance with SOP-99012. The division thanks Mr. Johnny Hendrix for his time and assistance. Please see the sections below for details regarding the inspection.

I. Permit

SOP-99012 authorizes the pump and haul system for process water and storm water from a natural gas compressor station, treated in an oil/water separator and collected in a retention pond. The permit was effective on April 1, 2020 and expires on March 31, 2025.

II. Documentation and Site Evaluation

An inspection of the facility grounds was conducted to observe site conditions and to identify any potential deficiencies that may need to be addressed. The retention pond and oil and water separator were observed. Signage was present at the pond. The onsite records and prior submitted electronic records were also examined. The site inspection and document evaluation yielded no observable deficiencies, and the compressor station is compliant with the SOP.
