Cleveland Hospital Company LLC dba Tennova Healthcare – Cleveland is requesting lower emission limits for the following sources:

- The boilers (06-0056-01) we request a PM limit of 0.58 pounds of PM per hour
- The boilers (06-0056-01) we request a SO2 limit of 0.05 pound of SOx per hour
- The 1,500 kW generator (06-0056-03) we request a PM limit of 4.0 pounds of PM per hour
- The 1,500 kW generator (06-0056-03) we request a SO2 limit of 5.0 pounds of SO2 per hour

We also request that our 800 kW generator be considered an insignificant source. Our boilers are operated as gas-fired boilers and only use No. 2 fuel oil as a backup fuel in a limited manner, with no more than 48 hours per year of non-emergency use for periodic testing, maintenance, or operator testing.
