Dear Mr. Collins:

Your construction permit application dated January 12, 2022, for silicon grinding was received on January 13, 2022, with additional information received on February 1, 2022. During the detailed review of the application and discussions with your personnel on May 6, 2022, the Division has determined that additional information is needed as follows to process the application:

- 1. An updated application (APC 100, 101, and 102) to reflect the change in baghouse flow rate from the original application.
- 2. An updated agreement letter for the PM limit for the source.

Please submit the additional information to the Technical Secretary at the letterhead address or email the information to Air.Pollution.Control@TN.gov in Adobe pdf format as soon as possible, but no later than June 2, 2022. Be advised that if this additional information is not received it is possible that enforcement action, potentially including civil penalties, may be taken.

This request is made under the authority provided by Tenn. Code Ann. § 68-201-105(b)(2) to require that any person furnish the department information required by it in discharge of its duties.

Pursuant to subparagraph (d) of Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulation 1200-03-26-.02(4), applicants have 180 days from the date they receive notification from the Division that their application is incomplete to correct any deficiencies. If additional deficiencies with the application are identified, you will be able to correct them within the remainder of the one hundred and eighty (180) day-period that begins on the date you received this letter. Failure to resolve this issue may result in denial of the application.
