On behalf of Franklin Asphalt, Inc., the following limitations are agreed upon for the above referenced facility:

- Production Limit shall not exceed 325,000 tons on all intervals of 12 consecutive months.
- CO emitted by this facility shall not exceed 70 tons per 12 consecutive months.
- PM emitted by this facility shall not exceed 53.72 tons per 12 consecutive months.

The only thing I would change is the statement about PM.

Good morning!

After reviewing the application for permit renewal and the agreement letter dated December 21, 2023, additional information is required in the agreement letter. Please provide an updated agreement letter with the original information as well as an annual limit for PM. The calculated source specific allowable PM emission limit is 48.72 ton per 12 consecutive months. To avoid annual recordkeeping of insignificant/exempt activities, you can add 5 tons per 12 consecutive months to include any insignificant/exempt activities at the site. The facility wide limit will be **53.72** ton per 12 consecutive months. Please be sure to include a stated yearly production limit as well as a facility wide limit for PM that includes an additional 5 tons per 12 consecutive months to account for any insignificant activity in the agreement letter.
