Additional Hearing Information:

he Department of Environment and Conservation proposes the Board of Water Quality, Oil and Gas undertake rulemaking to rescind a requirement for pollutant discharge permits that is based on a provision of the Clean Water Act that was repealed by Congress in 1981, has never been implemented by the EPA, and could impose excessively high treatment costs on municipal sewage treatment plants if implemented in accordance with the original intent of Congress.

Specifically, we propose to rescind Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 0400-40-05-.08(1)(c), which provides, "For publicly owned treatment works, effluent limitations shall be designed to require application of the best practicable waste treatment technology."

When it was first adopted, the Clean Water Act required municipal sewage treatment plants to comply with secondary treatment requirements by 1977 and with best practicable waste treatment technology limits by 1983. Although there is no current statutory or regulatory definition of "best practicable waste treatment technology," these 1983 limits were apparently intended by Congress to have been based on advanced treatment technology. Congress repealed the Clean Water Act provision (33 U.S.C. § 1311(b)(2)(B)) in 1981 due to the excessively high cost of implementation. Although the federal regulation is still compiled in the Code of Federal Regulations (40 C.F.R. § 125.3), it has no legal effect because it is tied to the non-existent statutory deadline. Accordingly, secondary treatment serves as the basis for technology-based limits for publicly owned treatment works.

At 1:00 p.m. CST, 2:00 p.m. EST, at all locations, the Department will take a few minutes before beginning the rulemaking hearing to answer questions about the proposed rule amendment.
