My name is Gary Bell. I am currently in a prison business program. We are being taught how to start our own business. I have 16 years experience in the carwash industry, and have been a manager twice. I am going to start a mobile detailing business when I get out in October of this year.

It will be at least three months before I can actually start my business. I understand that there is an EPA law to follow in order to operate a pressure washer. I do not want to ever be on the wrong side of the law again and am asking for your help to answer some of the questions I have. Please understand that I do not have internet access at this time.

- 1. If I am using environmental friendly products do I still have to have a permit?
- 2. If I trap and contain all my wash water do I still need a permit(if in compliance with the TN Water Quality Act of 1977)
- 3. I read that it takes 5-9 months to obtain a permit. Is there any work I can do until I am granted a permit?
- 4. If I want to work in Nashville and Chattanooga do I have to obtain two different permits or is one good for all Tennessee counties?
- 5. Can I go ahead and submit an application now or do I need to wait until my release?
- 6. Are there any other regulations I need to follow besides the Clean Water Act if so which ones??
- 7. Is a mobile detailing business considered a pump and haul system, or can you elaborate on it for me?
- 8. How much is the annual maintenance fee?
- 9. What systems are approved to remain in compliance with the EPA? (Wash mat, sand snake, etc.)
