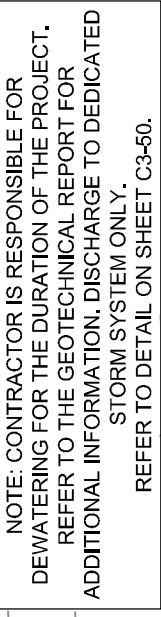

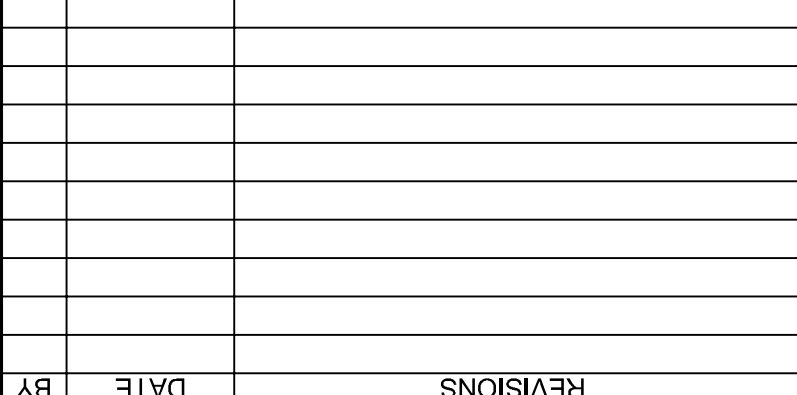

1. STOCKPILED TOPSOIL OR FILL MATERIAL IS TO BE ENTERED SO THE SEDIMENT RUNOFF WILL NOT CONTAMINATE SURROUNDING AREAS OR INTO NEARBY STREAMS. STOCKPILING SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN A MANNER THAT PREVENTS EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION. EROSIONS, SEDIMENT CONTROL PRACTICES SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO STOCKPILE EROSIONS.
2. ANY SITE USED FOR DISPOSAL AND/OR STOCKPILE OF ANY MATERIAL SHALL BE CONTRACTOR TO SEE THAT ALL REQUIRED PERMITS ARE OBTAINED FOR EACH PROPERTY UTILIZED. A COPY OF THE APPROVED PERMIT MUST BE PROVIDED TO THE INSPECTOR PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF WORK ON ANY PROPERTY. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY BE CONSIDERED A VIOLATION OF THE PERMIT AND SUBJECT TO FINES AND/OR A STOP WORK ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF ILLEGALLY PLACED MATERIAL AT THE OWN EXPENSE.
3. CONSTRUCTION SITES SHALL BE BARRIERS BEFORE BEGINNING GRADING OPERATIONS. UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, A MINIMUM OF 10' TEMPORARY EROSION CONTROL BARRIERS SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO ANY GRADING OPERATIONS. GRADING IS NOT TO BE CONDUCTED UNTIL 10 DAYS OF ACHIEVED VEGETATION UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED. CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE WATERWAYS MEASURES TO ESTABLISH PERMANENT SOIL STABILIZATION, STEP SLOPES (GREATER THAN 3:1) SHALL BE REVEGETATED WITH GRASS OR OTHER VEGETATION AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
