A condition of no exposure exists at an industrial facility when all industrial materials and activities are protected by a storm resistant shelter to prevent exposure to rain, snow, snowmelt, and/or runoff. Industrial materials or activities include, but are not limited to, material handling equipment or activities, industrial machinery, raw materials, intermediate products, by-products, final products, or waste products. Material handling activities include the storage, loading and unloading, transportation, or conveyance of any raw material, intermediate product, final product or waste product. A storm resistant shelter is not required for the following industrial materials and activities:

- drums, barrels, tanks, and similar containers that are tightly sealed, have clean exteriors, are not deteriorated and do not leak. "Sealed" means banded or otherwise secured and without operational taps or valves;
- clean pallets that are free of residuals;
- adequately maintained vehicles used in material handling; and
- final products, other than products that would be mobilized in stormwater discharges (e.g., rock salt).

A No Exposure Certification form must be submitted for each facility qualifying for the no exposure exclusion, and must be re-submitted **once every five years**. In addition, the exclusion from NPDES permitting is available on a facility-wide basis only, not for individual outfalls. If any industrial activities or materials are or will be exposed to precipitation and/or runoff, the facility is not eligible for the no exposure exclusion. Signing and submitting this No Exposure Certification form certifies that a condition of no exposure exists at its facility or site, and the facility is obligated to comply with the terms and conditions of 40 CFR 122.26(g).

## **Purpose of this Form and Instructions**

### **Who may file a No Exposure Certification form:**

Federal law at 40 CFR Part 122.26 prohibits point source discharges of stormwater associated with industrial activity to waters of the U.S. without a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. However, NPDES permit coverage is not required for discharges of stormwater associated with industrial activities identified at 40CFR 122.26(b)(14)(i)-(ix) and (xi) if the discharger can certify that a condition of no exposure exists at the industrial facility or site. Stormwater discharges from construction activities identified in 40 CFR 122.26(b)(14)(x) and (b)(15) are not eligible for the no exposure exclusion.

### **Obtaining and maintaining the no exposure exclusion:**

This form is used to certify that a condition of no exposure exists at the industrial facility or site described herein, and must be re-submitted **once every five years**. The Division will review the form for completeness and accuracy and notify the facility owner/operator if the application has been deemed complete or incomplete. The industrial facility operator must maintain a condition of no exposure at its facility or site in order for the no exposure exclusion to remain applicable. If conditions change resulting in the exposure of materials and activities to stormwater, the facility operator must obtain coverage under an NPDES stormwater permit.

The industrial facility operator must maintain a condition of no exposure at its facility or site in order for the no exposure exclusion to remain applicable. If conditions change resulting in the exposure of materials and activities to stormwater, the facility operator must obtain coverage under an NPDES stormwater permit.

### **Completing the form:**

1. Enter the latitude and longitude of the approximate center of the facility or site in decimal form.
2. Enter the 4-digit Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) code which identifies the facility's primary activity and second 4-digit SIC code identifying the facility's secondary activities, if applicable. SIC codes can be obtained from the United States Department of Labor website: <https://www.osha.gov/pls/imis/sicsearch.html>
3. Artificial entities (e.g., corporations or partnerships) must submit the correct Tennessee Secretary of State (SOS), Division of Business Services, control number. For general partnerships, the form must be signed by each general partner in the general partnership.
4. Enter the legal name of the person (under Facility Contact), firm, public organization, or any other entity that operates the facility described in this application. The operator of the facility is the legal entity which controls the facility's operation, rather than the plant or site manager.
5. Enter the complete mailing address, email address, telephone number, and position of the operator. This address will be used for any future correspondence between the Division and the facility operator.
6. Complete the Exposure Checklist. If you answer "Yes" to any of the questions, you are not eligible for a no exposure exclusion and do not need to submit the form.
7. Certification statement and signature. Enter the certifier's printed name, title, and email address. Sign and date the form.

### **Who must sign the No Exposure Certification form:**

For a corporation: Signed by a responsible corporate officer, which means: (i) president, secretary, treasurer, or vice-president of the corporation in charge of the principal business function, or any other person who performs similar policy or decision making functions, or (ii) the manager of one or more manufacturing, production, or operating facilities provided the manager is authorized to make management decisions which govern the operation of the regulated facility including having the explicit or implicit duty of making major capital investment recommendations, and initiating and directing other comprehensive measures to assure long term environmental compliance with environmental laws and regulations; the manager can ensure that the necessary systems are established or actions taken to gather complete and accurate information for application requirements; and where authority to sign documents has been assigned or delegated to the manager in accordance with corporate procedures;

For a partnership or sole proprietorship: Signed by a general partner(s) or the proprietor; or

For a municipality State, Federal, or other facility: Signed by either a principal executive office or ranking elected official.
