Dear Mr. Ladd:

The Division has reviewed your construction permit application dated February 8, 2012. Construction Permit 964318G requires Transglobal Oil Co. dba Bread Box Food Stores, Inc. to apply for an operating permit and submit the start-up certification within thirty (30) days of initial start-up. Based upon this review, the initial start-up date for the above-mentioned construction permit was August 15, 2011. Transglobal Oil Co. dba Bread Box Food Stores, Inc.'s operating permit application and start-up certification were not received until February 9, 2012. An operating permit is hereby issued for the operation described. Please note the conditions on the permit.

Division Rule 1200-03-09-.01(1)(d) states that construction of a new air contaminant source or the modification of an air contaminant source which may result in the discharge of air contaminants must be in accordance with the approved construction permit application, the provisions and stipulations set forth in the construction permit, all provisions of the regulations of this Division 1200-03, any applicable measures of the control strategy, and all provisions of the Tennessee Air Quality Act. Division Rule 1200-03-09-.02(2) states that no person shall operate an air contaminant source in Tennessee without first obtaining an operating permit from the Technical Secretary except as specifically exempted in rule 1200-03-09-.04 of this chapter.

The Tennessee Air Quality Act allows for enforcement action against individuals who violate the Act or its Regulations. The above described violation will be evaluated to determine if additional enforcement action is warranted. If you have any information that proves the violation did not occur, or if you have information that documents mitigating circumstances relative to the violation, you may submit that information in writing to the Technical Secretary, 9th Floor L & C Annex, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37243-1531. To ensure that information you wish to submit will be considered, it must be submitted within 20 days of your receipt of this notice of violation.
