Dear Ms. Wagner:

On January 13, 2010, you submitted administrative permit amendment requests to include "in-kind" turbine replacement language into the permits for sources 05-0132-01, 30-0183-01, 62-0094-01, and 65-0028-01. Any physical change in or change in the method of operation of an air contaminant source not subject to requirements of paragraphs 1200-03-09-.02(11) (Title V), 1200-03-09-.01(4) (Prevention of Significant Deterioration of Air Quality), and 1200-03-09-.01(5) (Nonattainment New Source Review), which does not result in emissions exceeding the emissions allowable under the existing operating permit and which does not result in the emission of any air contaminant not previously emitted, must comply with TAPCR 1200-03-02-.01(aa) 4. (Operational Flexibility). The air contaminant source must provide the Technical Secretary with written notification of at least 7 days in advance of the proposed change. The written notification must contain a brief description of the change, the date on which the change will occur, pollutants emitted, declaration of any change in emissions, and any applicable requirements that would apply as a result of the change. The written notice must also contain a statement that the change does not result in emissions exceeding the emissions allowable under the existing operating permit.

The requested amendments are not required to make the changes described above. Routine maintenance, repair, and replacement are not considered physical changes, and notification is not required.
