This correspondence is in response to your letters dated January 29, 2010. The information that you provided has undergone a preliminary review by the Division.

The Tennessee Air Pollution Control Board has adopted regulations which exempt certain types of operations from permit requirements. Internal combustion driven electric generator sets, when used exclusively for emergency replacement or standby service, and meet the requirements of Rule 1200-3-9-.04(5)(f) 37. do not require a permit.

All applicable air pollution regulations must still be met by your facility
