Subject: Notification of Compliance for Liquid Chemical Destructor; Hazardous Waste Combustor MACT (40 CFR 63 Subpart EEE); PES B-248-2; MSOP-32


Enclosed please find a Notification of Compliance (NOC) report for Tennessee Operations of Eastman Chemical Company's (Eastman) Liquid Chemical Destructor conducted on December 11 and 12, 2012. Pursuant to 40 CFR 63.1207(d)(1) a periodic CPT must commence within 61 months of the previous CPT which was conducted on October 3 and 4, 2007 and the NOC submitted within 90 days of completion of the CPT per 40 CFR 63.1207(j)(1). Eastman planned to initiate testing on October 2, 2012 but was unable to achieve targeted operating conditions. Eastman submitted an extension request to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) on October 9, 2012 and a 6-month extension request was granted on October 16, 2012.

In accordance with 40 CFR 63.1210(b)(2), the operating parameter limits identified in this NOC, shall be complied with upon postmark of this submittal and the limits identified in the previous NOC are no longer applicable.

Pursuant to 40 CFR 63.1206(c)(1)(v), Eastman is also submitting today under separate cover an Administrative Amendment to Major Source Operating Permit (MSOP) 32 to incorporate the operating requirements specified in this NOC into the Title V Operating Permit.
