Dear Mr. Lallathin:

This correspondence is in response to your letter dated November 7, 2014. The information that you provided has undergone a preliminary review by the permit program.

It has been determined that the change described in your letter (replacing a 66 inch two color printer slotter) does <u>not</u> constitute a *modification*, as defined in subparagraph 1200-03-02-.01(1)(aa) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations. Specifically, the proposed change would not result in emissions from the source exceeding the emissions allowable under the existing operating permit 466831. Therefore, the source will not require a new construction permit at this time.

Part 1200-03-02-.01(1)(aa)4. requires that written notification be provided to the Technical Secretary at least seven days in advance of such a change. Your letter is accepted as the required notification. You should attach a copy of your letter to permit number 466831, as required by that part.
