The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (APC) has received and reviewed a Permit-by-Rule Transition Program Qualification form for the following sources:

Stationary Emergency Engine(s)

Verizon Wireless Tennessee Partnership dba Verizon Wireless Fincastle A

340 Fincastle Road, LaFollette, Campbell County

We have determined that this form is complete and the above mentioned source(s) qualify for the APC's Permit-by-Rule Transition Program in which I, as Technical Secretary, am exercising my discretion to not seek enforcement for constructing and/or operating the above mentioned source(s) without first receiving an air quality construction and/or operating permit.

In the Permit-by-Rule Transition Program Qualification form, you made four commitments:

- 1. To comply with the applicable regulatory requirements for the source(s) for which the form is submitted
- 2. To notify the APC of any changes to the information included on the form in a timely manner
- 3. To complete a Notice of Intent to operate under the Permit-by-Rule within 60 days after the effective date of the APC's regulation allowing Permit-by-Rule for source(s) for which the form was submitted (unless notified by APC that the source is exempt from permitting altogether)
- That the source(s) is not located at a Title V or Conditional Major facility

Should you need to update information contained in the Permit-by-Rule Transition Program Qualification form, please submit a letter indicating such changes, along with a copy of this letter and your original form either by mail to the address shown above or via email to Air.Pollution.Control@tn.gov.

The APC will contact you using the contact information contained on the form (or revised contact information if supplied as noted above) once the rules allowing you to apply for a permit-by-rule for the sources covered by this transition program have been adopted.
