This correspondence is being provided to the Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control to document that the LaFollette Medical Center located in LaFollette, Tennessee, has agreed to accept a permit condition for our emergency generators limiting total sulfur dioxide (SO₂) emissions to 0.51 pounds per hour (lb/hr) and 0.13 tons per year (tpy). These limits correspond to the maximum potential SO₂ emissions from the two emergency generators at the facility.
