Eastman Chemical Company has applied to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, Division of Air Pollution Control for a significant modification to an existing major source (Title V) operating permit subject to the provisions of paragraph 1200-03-09-02(11) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations. A major source operating permit is required by both the Federal Clean Air Act and the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations.

Eastman Chemical Company has applied for a significant modification to establish or change permit terms or conditions for which there is no corresponding underlying applicable requirement and that the source has assumed to avoid an applicable requirement to which the source would otherwise be subject. The Title V operating permit subject to the modification is identified as follows: Division identification number 82-0003/568618 (MSOP-16). The specific permit conditions affected by this modification are identified as follows:

1. Conditions B10 and B11 (report required upon the issuance of a notice of violation for excess emissions);

2. Condition E1 (Title V fees);

3. Condition E2-1 (Title V reporting requirements);

4. Conditions E7-1 through E7-16 (Crude Acetic Anhydride Manufacturing (82-0003-297/PES B-Area A-B7));

This significant modification is conducted pursuant to subpart 1200-03-09-.02(11)(f)5(iv) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations. Only the portion of the Title V permit affected by the significant modification is open to comment during the notice period.

EPA has agreed to treat these draft Part 70 permits as proposed Part 70 permits and to perform its 45-day review provided by the law concurrently with the public notice period. If any substantive comments are received, EPA's 45-day review period will cease to be performed concurrently with the public notice period. EPA's 45-day review period will start once the public notice period has been completed and EPA receives notification from the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Division that comments have been received and resolved. Whether EPA's 45-day review period is performed concurrently with the public comment period or after the public comment period has ended, the deadline for citizen's petitions to the EPA Administrator will be determined as if EPA's 45-day review period is performed after the public comment period has ended (i.e., sequentially).
