On July 13, 2018, I conducted a site visit to your facility located at 419 Industrial Drive, White House, TN. This site visit was in response to a file review which showed that Operating Permit #051770P for this facility expired on October 1, 2008.

During the site visit on July 13, 2018, permit applications were left with you and an email was sent to you on July 25, 2018, with a deadline to submit the attached permit applications no later than August 19, 2018. As of the date of this letter, the Division of Air Pollution Control has not received the permit applications.
