Re: International Paper, Change in Air Pollution Control Equipment (32-0028/456744)

Dear Mr. Thompson:

This correspondence is in response to your letter dated December 1, 2011. The information that you provided has undergone a preliminary review by the permit program.

It has been determined that the changes described in your letter (replacement of existing cyclone) do <u>not</u> constitute a *modification*, as defined in Rule 1200-03-02-.01(1)(aa) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations. Specifically, the proposed changes would not result in an increase in emissions from this source. Based on the information contained in your letter, the source would continue to meet the installation description and emission limitations as stated on your current permit (#456744). Therefore, the source will not require a new construction/modification permit at this time.

Rule 1200-03-09-.02(7) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations requires the owner or operator of an air contaminant source to notify the Division at least 30 days prior to any change in air pollution control equipment.
