As required by Rule 0400-11-01-.02(6)(b)1 of the Solid Waste Processing and Disposal Regulations, the Tennessee Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM, the Division) has reviewed your written request for an amendment to the Permit-by-Rule for the Greeneville/Greene County Transfer Station. The request consisted of modifying the existing transfer station permit to remove a household paint collection center (latex, oil, and lead-based paints) and solidification activity.
