Dear Mayor Spencer:

Through investigation by personnel of the Division of Solid Waste Management, the Division must allege that you have violated the *Tennessee Solid Waste Disposal Act*, T.C.A. §§ 68-211-104 (3) and (4).

T.C.A. §§ 68-211-104 (3) and (4) state:

It is unlawful to:

- (3) Construct, alter, or operate a solid waste processing or disposal facility or site in violation of the rules, regulations, or orders of the commissioner or in such a manner as to create a public nuisance; or
- (4) Transport, process or dispose of solid waste in violation of this chapter, the rules and regulations established under this chapter or in violation of the orders of the commissioner or board.

Tennessee Code Annotated Section 68-211-112 authorizes the Commissioner or his designee, prior to any enforcement action, to request the presence of an alleged violator to show cause why enforcement action ought not to be taken by the Department. Among the enforcement actions available to the Department is the assessment of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) PER DAY PENALTY for violation of the *Tennessee Solid Waste Disposal Act* (68-211-101 et seq.).

Therefore, we are requesting that you meet with us on Thursday, April 8, 2014, at 1:00 p.m. CDT and show cause why this Department should not take enforcement action, including the assessment of an appropriate civil penalty. Our office is located on the fourteenth floor of the William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L Parks Avenue, Nashville, Tennessee. You or your representatives should bring all relevant information, reports, and documents pertaining to your Class I solid waste disposal facility. Please be prepared to discuss this matter in detail with reasonable accuracy.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Hardeman County may not accept solid waste for disposal into Phase IV of the Hardeman County Class I Disposal Facility, SNL 35-0223 due to the fact that Phase IV was not constructed in accordance with the permit. This is a violation of Tennessee Code Annotated §68-211-105(b) and the terms and conditions of your operating permit.

T.C.A. §68-211-105(b) provides:

No new construction shall be initiated nor shall any change be made in any solid waste processing facility or disposal facility or site until the plans for such new construction or change have been submitted to and approved by the department.

On April 10, 2013, the Division of Solid Waste Management received the Construction Quality Control Report certified by Construction Material Laboratory, Inc. prepared for Barge Waggoner Sumner & Cannon, Inc. detailing design changes that were made during the construction of Phase IV of the facility. These design changes constitute modifications of the operating permit that were not approved in accordance with the procedures outlined in Division Rule 0400-11-01-.02(6)(b).

Division Rule 0400-11-01-.04(4)(a)7.(i) states, in pertinent part, that "The leachate collection and removal system must be designed, constructed, operated and maintained such that the leachate depth over the liner does not exceed one foot..." The design changes created a difference in elevation between the cell floor of Phase III and Phase IV

of the disposal facility. This difference in elevation has created head of greater than one foot over an undetermined surficial area of the floor of Phase III of the facility.

Further the design changes have caused the facility to be in violation of Division Rule 0400-11-010.04(5) which states, in pertinent part, "A leachate collection and removal system is required immediately above the liner that is designed, constructed, maintained and operated to collect and remove leachate from the facility. Observation made by Mr. James Warren and Mr. Ron Potts, during their August 7, 2013 inspection indicate the temporary leachate line located underneath the constructed Phase IV is transporting significant amounts of leachate.

Leachate flow through the temporary leachate pipe located below the Phase IV liner must be eliminated. Also, any penetrations through the Phase II or Phase III primary liner must be properly repaired in accordance with the Construction Quality Assurance Plan.

The alignment of the main leachate line located in Phase IV of the disposal facility is approximately 30 feet south of the Phase III leachate main line. Also, the connection of the Phase II leachate main line to the Phase IV leachate collection main is not located on the as-built drawings.

Within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this letter, please submit a permit modification request which details how the leachate migration control standards specified in Division Rule 0400-11-01-.04(4) will be met. Placement of waste into Phase IV may begin upon approval of the permit modification.

PERMIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Re-certification by Permittee for Facilities Whose Initial Operation is Delayed If the facility does not initiate construction and/or operation within one year of the date of this permit, the permittee must re-certify the application in accordance with Rule 1200-1-7-.02(2)(d).
- 2. Duty to Comply The permittee must comply with all conditions of this permit, unless otherwise authorized by the Department. Any permit noncompliance, except as otherwise authorized by the Department, constitutes a violation of the Act and is grounds for enforcement action, or for permit termination, revocation and re-issuance, or modification.
- 3. Need to Halt or Reduce Activity Not a Defense It shall not be a defense for a permittee in an enforcement action that it would have been necessary to halt or reduce the permitted activity in order to maintain compliance with the conditions of this permit.
- 4. Duty to Mitigate In the event of noncompliance with the permit, the permittee shall take all reasonable steps to minimize releases to the environment, and shall carry out such measures as are reasonable to prevent adverse impacts on human health or the environment.
- 5. Proper Operation and Maintenance The permittee shall at all times properly operate and maintain all facilities and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) which are installed or used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit. Proper operation and maintenance includes effective performance, adequate funding, adequate operator staffing and training, and adequate laboratory and process controls, including appropriate quality assurance procedures. This provision requires the operation of back-up or auxiliary facilities or similar systems only when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit.
- 6. Permit Actions This permit may be modified, revoked and re-issued, or terminated for cause. The filing of a request by the permittee for a permit modification, revocation and re-issuance, or termination, or a notification of planned changes or anticipated noncompliance, does not stay any existing permit condition.
- 7. Property Rights This permit does not convey any property rights of any sort, or any exclusive privilege.
- 8. Duty to Provide Information The permittee shall furnish to the Commissioner, within a reasonable time, any relevant information which the Commissioner may request to determine whether cause exists for modifying, revoking and re-issuing, or terminating this permit, or to determine compliance with this permit. The permittee must also furnish to the Commissioner, upon request, copies required to be kept by this permit. All records, including a copy of this permit and the approved Part I and Part II application, must be maintained at the facility or other locations as approved by the Commissioner.

- 9. <u>Inspection and Entry</u> The permittee shall allow the Commissioner, or an authorized representative, to:
 - (i) Enter at any reasonable time the permittee's premises where a regulated facility or activity is located or conducted, or where records must be kept under the conditions of this permit;
 - (ii) Have access to and copy, at reasonable times, any records that must be kept under the conditions of this permit;
 - (iii) Inspect at any reasonable time any facilities, equipment (including monitoring and control equipment), practices or operations regulated or required under this permit (Note: If requested by the permittee at the time of sampling, the Commissioner shall split with the permittee any samples taken.);
 - (iv) Sample or monitor at reasonable times, for the purposes of assuring permit compliance or as otherwise authorized by the Act any substances or parameters at any location; and
 - (v) Make photographs for the purpose of documenting items of compliance or noncompliance at waste management units, or where appropriate to protect legitimate proprietary interests, require the permittee to make such photos for the Commissioner.

10. Monitoring and Records

- (i) Samples and measurements taken for the purpose of monitoring shall be representative of the monitored activity.
- (ii) The permittee shall retain records of all required monitoring information. The permittee shall maintain records for all groundwater monitoring wells and associated ground-water surface elevations, for the active life of the facility, and for the postclosure care period as well. This period may be extended by request of the Commissioner at any time.
- (iii) Records of monitoring information shall include:
 - (I) The date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;
 - (II) The individual(s) who performed the sampling or measurements;
 - (III) The date(s) analyses were performed;
 - (IV) The individual(s) who performed the analyses;
 - (V) The analytical techniques or methods used (including equipment used); and
 - (VI) The results of such analyses.

11. Reporting Requirements

- (i) The permittee shall give notice to the Commissioner as soon as possible of any planned physical alterations or additions to the permitted facility.
- (ii) Monitoring results shall be reported at the intervals specified elsewhere in this permit.
- (iii) The permittee shall report orally within 24 hours from the time the permittee becomes aware of the circumstances of any release, discharge, fire, or explosion from the permitted solid waste facility which could threaten the environment or human health outside the facility. Such report shall be made to the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency, using the 24-hour toll-free number 1-800-262-3300.
- (iv) Where the permittee becomes aware that it failed to submit any relevant facts in a permit application, or submitted incorrect information in a permit application or in any report to the Commissioner, it shall promptly submit such facts or information.

12. Periodic Survey

- (i) Within 60 days of his receipt of the written request of the Commissioner to do so, the permittee shall cause to be conducted a survey of active and/or closed portions of his facility in order to determine if operations (e.g., cut and fill boundaries, grades) are being conducted in accordance with the approved design and operational plans. The permittee must report the results of such survey to the Commissioner within 90 days of his receipt of the Commissioner's request.
- (ii) The Commissioner may request such a survey:
 - (I) If he has reason to believe that operations are being conducted in a manner that significantly deviates from the approved plans; and/or
 - (II) As a periodic verification (but no more than annually) that operations are being conducted in accordance with the approved plans.
- (iii) Any survey performed pursuant to this part must be performed by a qualified land surveyor duly authorized under Tennessee law to conduct such activities.
- 13. <u>Duration of Permits</u> This permit shall be effective for the operating life of the facility.
- 14. <u>Effect of Permit</u> The issuance of this permit does not authorize the permittee to injure persons or property or to invade other private rights, or to violate any local law or regulations.
- 15. <u>Transfer, Modification, Revocation and Re-issuance, and Termination of Permits</u> This permit may be transferred, modified, revoked or reissued, or terminated as set forth in 1200-1-7-.02(5).

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- 16. <u>Applicable Standards</u> All applicable facility standards of Rule Chapter 1200-1-7, <u>Solid Waste Processing and Disposal Amendments</u> shall be considered conditions of this registration.
- 17. <u>Penalties</u> Any violation of the conditions or other terms of this registration may subject the registrant to the penalties set forth in Tennessee Code Annotated Section 68-211-114 and 68-211-117.
- 18. <u>Hazardous Waste Restriction</u> No hazardous waste, as regulated by the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act (TCA Section 68-212-101, <u>et seq.</u>), and the Rules adopted pursuant to that Act, shall be accepted at this facility.
- 19. <u>Construction and Operation</u> The permittee shall construct and operate the facility in accordance with the approved engineering plans and operations manual which becomes a condition of this permit as Attachment I.
- 20. <u>Financial Assurance</u> Prior to beginning operation, the permittee must file a Financial Assurance Instrument in accordance with Rule 1200-1-7-.03.
- 21. Special Waste Except as specifically provided for in the Facility-Specific Conditions of this permit, the permittee may not accept for disposal any special waste unless approved to do so in writing by this Department.
- 22. <u>Automobile Batteries</u> This facility is specifically prohibited from accepting automobile batteries for disposal.

VARIANCES AND WAIVERS

The following variances or waivers from standards or requirements in Rule 1200-1-7, <u>Solid Waste Processing and Disposal Amendments</u>, are hereby granted in accordance with Rule 1200-1-7-.01(5):

- 1. Due to the local unavailability of suitable soils for construction of the final cap, the Permittee has requested permission to use available soils, augmented with a welded sheet Very Low Density Polyethylene (VLDP) material to meet the necessary cap permeability requirements. The Division of Solid Waste Management is hereby granting this variance request, subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - (i) The Permittee must monitor and record both the local rainfall amounts and the leachate generation rates.
 - (ii) The information must be used by the Permittee, or their consultant, to verify that the alternate cap design is equivalent to the performance standard of the current solid waste management regulations.
 - (iii) In the event that equivalent performance cannot be demonstrated, the Permittee will be required to modify the design such that equivalent performance can be demonstrated.
- 2. A variance is granted from the site buffer requirements of Rule 1200-7-1-.04(3)(a) to allow a drainage structure within fifty (50) feet of the property boundary.

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FACILITY-SPECIFIC PERMIT CONDITIONS

The following conditions of this permit are established pursuant to Rule 1200-1-7-.02(4)(b):

- 1. The sediment control structure shall be inspected for stability and/or erosion every two (2) months and after every major rain event and shall be cleaned when the volume of sediment in the structure is equal to one-half (1/2) the total capacity of the structure.
- 2. All monitoring wells shall be installed, and samples shall be taken by the applicant to be analyzed before any waste is accepted for disposal in this site.
- 3. Landfill operations shall adhere to recommendations as specified in the geologic report.
- 4. During the entirety of the post-closure period for Phase I of the facility, adequate erosion control on the crown and side slopes of the filled area must be maintained. In the event that side-slope erosion becomes a chronic problem, the facility may be required to install additional interceptor berms on the side-slopes, as well as runoff let-down structures, armored ditches, and energy-dissipation devices.







PERMIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Re-certification by Permittee for Facilities Whose Initial Operation is Delayed If the facility does not initiate construction and/or operation within one year of the date of this permit, the permittee must re-certify the application in accordance with Rule 1200-1-7-.02(2)(d).
- 2. <u>Duty to Comply</u> The permittee must comply with all conditions of this permit, unless otherwise authorized by the Department. Any permit noncompliance, except as otherwise authorized by the Department, constitutes a violation of the Act and is grounds for enforcement action, or for permit termination, revocation and re-issuance, or modification.
- 3. Need to Halt or Reduce Activity Not a Defense It shall not be a defense for a permittee in an enforcement action that it would have been necessary to halt or reduce the permitted activity in order to maintain compliance with the conditions of this permit.
- 4. <u>Duty to Mitigate</u> In the event of noncompliance with the permit, the permittee shall take all reasonable steps to minimize releases to the environment, and shall carry out such measures as are reasonable to prevent adverse impacts on human health or the environment.
- 5. Proper Operation and Maintenance The permittee shall at all times properly operate and maintain all facilities and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) which are installed or used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit. Proper operation and maintenance includes effective performance, adequate funding, adequate operator staffing and training, and adequate laboratory and process controls, including appropriate quality assurance procedures. This provision requires the operation of back-up or auxiliary facilities or similar systems only when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit.
- 6. <u>Permit Actions</u> This permit may be modified, revoked and re-issued, or terminated for cause. The filing of a request by the permittee for a permit modification, revocation and re-issuance, or termination, or a notification of planned changes or anticipated noncompliance, does not stay any existing permit condition.
- 7. <u>Property Rights</u> This permit does not convey any property rights of any sort, or any exclusive privilege.
- 8. <u>Duty to Provide Information</u> The permittee shall furnish to the Commissioner, within a reasonable time, any relevant information which the Commissioner may request to determine whether cause exists for modifying, revoking and re-issuing, or terminating this permit, or to determine compliance with this permit. The permittee must also furnish to the Commissioner, upon request, copies required to be kept by this permit. All records, including a copy of this permit and the approved Part I and Part II application, must be maintained at the facility or other locations as approved by the Commissioner.

- 9. <u>Inspection and Entry</u> The permittee shall allow the Commissioner, or an authorized representative, to:
 - (i) Enter at any reasonable time the permittee's premises where a regulated facility or activity is located or conducted, or where records must be kept under the conditions of this permit;
 - (ii) Have access to and copy, at reasonable times, any records that must be kept under the conditions of this permit:
 - (iii) Inspect at any reasonable time any facilities, equipment (including monitoring and control equipment), practices or operations regulated or required under this permit (Note: If requested by the permittee at the time of sampling, the Commissioner shall split with the permittee any samples taken.);
 - (iv) Sample or monitor at reasonable times, for the purposes of assuring permit compliance or as otherwise authorized by the Act any substances or parameters at any location; and
 - (v) Make photographs for the purpose of documenting items of compliance or noncompliance at waste management units, or where appropriate to protect legitimate proprietary interests, require the permittee to make such photos for the Commissioner.

10. Monitoring and Records

- (i) Samples and measurements taken for the purpose of monitoring shall be representative of the monitored activity.
- (ii) The permittee shall retain records of all required monitoring information. The permittee shall maintain records for all groundwater monitoring wells and associated ground-water surface elevations, for the active life of the facility, and for the post-closure care period as well. This period may be extended by request of the Commissioner at any time.
- (iii) Records of monitoring information shall include:
 - (I) The date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;
 - (II) The individual(s) who performed the sampling or measurements;
 - (III) The date(s) analyses were performed;
 - (IV) The individual(s) who performed the analyses;
 - (V) The analytical techniques or methods used (including equipment used); and
 - (VI) The results of such analyses.

11. Reporting Requirements

- (i) The permittee shall give notice to the Commissioner as soon as possible of any planned physical alterations or additions to the permitted facility.
- (ii) Monitoring results shall be reported at the intervals specified elsewhere in this permit.
- (iii) The permittee shall report orally within 24 hours from the time the permittee becomes aware of the circumstances of any release, discharge, fire, or explosion from the permitted solid waste facility which could threaten the environment or human health outside the facility. Such report shall be made to the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency, using the 24-hour toll-free number 1-800-262-3300.
- (iv) Where the permittee becomes aware that it failed to submit any relevant facts in a permit application, or submitted incorrect information in a permit application or in any report to the Commissioner, it shall promptly submit such facts or information.

12. Periodic Survey

- (i) Within 60 days of his receipt of the written request of the Commissioner to do so, the permittee shall cause to be conducted a survey of active and/or closed portions of his facility in order to determine if operations (e.g., cut and fill boundaries, grades) are being conducted in accordance with the approved design and operational plans. The permittee must report the results of such survey to the Commissioner within 90 days of his receipt of the Commissioner's request.
- (ii) The Commissioner may request such a survey:
 - (I) If he has reason to believe that operations are being conducted in a manner that significantly deviates from the approved plans; and/or
 - (II) As a periodic verification (but no more than annually) that operations are being conducted in accordance with the approved plans.
- (iii) Any survey performed pursuant to this part must be performed by a qualified land surveyor duly authorized under Tennessee law to conduct such activities.
- 13. Duration of Permits This permit shall be effective for the operating life of the facility.
- 14. <u>Effect of Permit</u> The issuance of this permit does not authorize the permittee to injure persons or property or to invade other private rights, or to violate any local law or regulations.
- 15. <u>Transfer, Modification, Revocation and Re-issuance, and Termination of Permits</u> This permit may be transferred, modified, revoked or reissued, or terminated as set forth in 1200-1-7-.02(5).

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- 16. <u>Applicable Standards</u> All applicable facility standards of Rule Chapter 1200-1-7, <u>Solid Waste Processing and Disposal Amendments</u> shall be considered conditions of this registration.





PERMIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Re-certification by Permittee for Facilities Whose Initial Operation is Delayed If the facility does not initiate construction and/or operation within one year of the date of this permit, the permittee must re-certify the application in accordance with Rule 1200-1-7-.02(2)(d).
- 2. <u>Duty to Comply</u> The permittee must comply with all conditions of this permit, unless otherwise authorized by the Department. Any permit noncompliance, except as otherwise authorized by the Department, constitutes a violation of the Act and is grounds for enforcement action, or for permit termination, revocation and re-issuance, or modification.
- 3. <u>Need to Halt or Reduce Activity Not a Defense</u> It shall not be a defense for a permittee in an enforcement action that it would have been necessary to halt or reduce the permitted activity in order to maintain compliance with the conditions of this permit.
- 4. <u>Duty to Mitigate</u> In the event of noncompliance with the permit, the permittee shall take all reasonable steps to minimize releases to the environment, and shall carry out such measures as are reasonable to prevent adverse impacts on human health or the environment.
- 5. Proper Operation and Maintenance The permittee shall at all times properly operate and maintain all facilities and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) which are installed or used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit. Proper operation and maintenance includes effective performance, adequate funding, adequate operator staffing and training, and adequate laboratory and process controls, including appropriate quality assurance procedures. This provision requires the operation of back-up or auxiliary facilities or similar systems only when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit.
- 6. <u>Permit Actions</u> This permit may be modified, revoked and re-issued, or terminated for cause. The filing of a request by the permittee for a permit modification, revocation and re-issuance, or termination, or a notification of planned changes or anticipated noncompliance, does not stay any existing permit condition.
- 7. <u>Property Rights</u> This permit does not convey any property rights of any sort, or any exclusive privilege.
- 8. <u>Duty to Provide Information</u> The permittee shall furnish to the Commissioner, within a reasonable time, any relevant information which the Commissioner may request to determine whether cause exists for modifying, revoking and re-issuing, or terminating this permit, or to determine compliance with this permit. The permittee must also furnish to the Commissioner, upon request, copies required to be kept by this permit. All records, including a copy of this permit and the approved Part I and Part II application, must be maintained at the facility or other locations as approved by the Commissioner.

- 9. <u>Inspection and Entry</u> The permittee shall allow the Commissioner, or an authorized representative, to:
 - Enter at any reasonable time the permittee's premises where a regulated facility or activity is located or conducted, or where records must be kept under the conditions of this permit;
 - (ii) Have access to and copy, at reasonable times, any records that must be kept under the conditions of this permit;
 - (iii) Inspect at any reasonable time any facilities, equipment (including monitoring and control equipment), practices or operations regulated or required under this permit (Note: If requested by the permittee at the time of sampling, the Commissioner shall split with the permittee any samples taken.);
 - (iv) Sample or monitor at reasonable times, for the purposes of assuring permit compliance or as otherwise authorized by the Act any substances or parameters at any location; and
 - (v) Make photographs for the purpose of documenting items of compliance or noncompliance at waste management units, or where appropriate to protect legitimate proprietary interests, require the permittee to make such photos for the Commissioner.

10. Monitoring and Records

- (i) Samples and measurements taken for the purpose of monitoring shall be representative of the monitored activity.
- (ii) The permittee shall retain records of all required monitoring information. The permittee shall maintain records for all groundwater monitoring wells and associated ground-water surface elevations, for the active life of the facility, and for the post-closure care period as well. This period may be extended by request of the Commissioner at any time.
- (iii) Records of monitoring information shall include:
 - (I) The date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;
 - (II) The individual(s) who performed the sampling or measurements;
 - (III) The date(s) analyses were performed;
 - (IV) The individual(s) who performed the analyses;
 - (V) The analytical techniques or methods used (including equipment used); and
 - (VI) The results of such analyses.

11. Reporting Requirements

- (i) The permittee shall give notice to the Commissioner as soon as possible of any planned physical alterations or additions to the permitted facility.
- (ii) Monitoring results shall be reported at the intervals specified elsewhere in this permit.
- (iii) The permittee shall report orally within 24 hours from the time the permittee becomes aware of the circumstances of any release, discharge, fire, or explosion from the permitted solid waste facility which could threaten the environment or human health outside the facility. Such report shall be made to the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency, using the 24-hour toll-free number 1-800-262-3300.
- (iv) Where the permittee becomes aware that it failed to submit any relevant facts in a permit application, or submitted incorrect information in a permit application or in any report to the Commissioner, it shall promptly submit such facts or information.

12. Periodic Survey

- (i) Within 60 days of his receipt of the written request of the Commissioner to do so, the permittee shall cause to be conducted a survey of active and/or closed portions of his facility in order to determine if operations (e.g., cut and fill boundaries, grades) are being conducted in accordance with the approved design and operational plans. The permittee must report the results of such survey to the Commissioner within 90 days of his receipt of the Commissioner's request.
- (ii) The Commissioner may request such a survey:
 - (I) If he has reason to believe that operations are being conducted in a manner that significantly deviates from the approved plans; and/or
 - (II) As a periodic verification (but no more than annually) that operations are being conducted in accordance with the approved plans.
- (iii) Any survey performed pursuant to this part must be performed by a qualified land surveyor duly authorized under Tennessee law to conduct such activities.
- 13. <u>Duration of Permits</u> This permit shall be effective for the operating life of the facility.
- 14. <u>Effect of Permit</u> The issuance of this permit does not authorize the permittee to injure persons or property or to invade other private rights, or to violate any local law or regulations.
- 15. <u>Transfer, Modification, Revocation and Re-issuance, and Termination of Permits</u> This permit may be transferred, modified, revoked or reissued, or terminated as set forth in 1200-1-7-.02(5).

- 16. <u>Applicable Standards</u> All applicable facility standards of Rule Chapter 1200-1-7, <u>Solid Waste Processing and Disposal Amendments</u> shall be considered conditions of this registration.
- 17. <u>Penalties</u> Any violation of the conditions or other terms of this registration may subject the registrant to the penalties set forth in Tennessee Code Annotated Section 68-211-114 and 68-211-117.
- 18. <u>Hazardous Waste Restriction</u> No hazardous waste, as regulated by the Tennessee Hazardous Waste Management Act (TCA Section 68-212-101, <u>et seg.</u>), and the Rules adopted pursuant to that Act, shall be accepted at this facility.
- 19. Construction and Operation The permittee shall construct and operate the facility in accordance with the approved engineering plans and operations manual which becomes a condition of this permit as Attachment I.
- 20. <u>Financial Assurance</u> Prior to beginning operation, the permittee must file a Financial Assurance Instrument in accordance with Rule 1200-1-7-.03.
- 21. <u>Special Waste</u> Except as specifically provided for in the Facility-Specific Conditions of this permit, the permittee may not accept for disposal any special waste unless approved to do so in writing by this Department.
- 22. <u>Automobile Batteries</u> This facility is specifically prohibited from accepting automobile batteries for disposal.

VARIANCES AND WAIVERS

The following variances or waivers from standards or requirements in Rule 1200-1-7, Solid Waste Processing and Disposal Amendments, are hereby granted in accordance with Rule 1200-1-7-.01(5):

1. A variance is granted from site buffer requirements of Rule 1200-7-1.04(3)(a) to allow a drainage structure within 50 feet of the property boundary.

FACILITY-SPECIFIC PERMIT CONDITIONS

The following conditions of this permit are established pursuant to Rule 1200-1-7-.02(4)(b):

- 1. The sediment control structure shall be inspected for stability and/or erosion every two (2) months and after every major rain event and shall be cleaned when the volume of sediment in the structure is equal to one-half (1/2) the total capacity of the structure.
- 2. All monitoring wells shall be installed, and samples shall be taken by the applicant to be analyzed before any waste is accepted for disposal in this site.
- 3. Landfill operations shall adhere to recommendations as specified in the geologic report.
