To Whom It May Concern:

Division of Water Resources personnel conducted a site visit at the referenced location on 6/21/2022. The purpose of the site visit was to assess the jurisdictional status of onsite water features "Stream-1" (Figure 1).

Stream1 is a jurisdictional stream, waters of the State of Tennessee, based on Primary indicator #5 “Presence of multiple populations of obligate lotic organisms with a greater than equal 2 month aquatic phase”. This determination is valid for only your own **current property lines**.

further evaluations will need to be done either upstream or downstream of these segments. Please be advised that any other areas of the property that may have water feature present and would need to be evaluated in the future.

Alterations to waters of the State of Tennessee, including wetlands, require coverage under an Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit (ARAP) from this Division. Any alterations to wet weather conveyances must be made in accordance with the requirements of Tenn. Code Ann. § 69-3-108(q).

Please be aware that hydrologic determinations are advised and governed by Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) rules and regulations and therefore only apply to the State’s permitting process. Water features located onsite may also be considered jurisdictional Waters of the United States; therefore, alterations to them should only be performed after consultation with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (865-986-7296).
