Thank you for submitting the Hydrologic Determination Report associated with the 3706 John Lunn Road in Spring Hill, Williamson County, Tennessee. Based on the results of a TDEC site visit, the information submitted in the Hydrologic Determination Report and the division's rules and guidelines regarding hydrologic determinations; the division accepts the jurisdictional determination of the water features as portrayed in the submitted report and revisions.

Alterations to any streams, wetlands or other waters determined to be jurisdictional by the USACE will require an Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit (ARAP)/§401 Certification. Additionally, the alteration of some features may require authorization of an ARAP even if the feature does not require a USACE permit. Alterations to wet weather conveyances must maintain sufficient Best Management Practices (BMPs) to prevent materials from leaving the work areas and causing adverse impacts to other waters
