Dear Mr. Turnbow:

The Division has reviewed your application to stabilize the east dike at the Kingston Fossil Plant. The Division has reasonable assurance the activity as proposed and in accordance with all permit conditions herein will not violate applicable water quality standards. The attached permit (enclosed) authorizes the activity pursuant to *The Tennessee Water Quality Control Act of 1977* (T.C.A. §69-3-101 et seq.) and §401 water quality certification (pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act 33 U.S.C. 1341).

The state of Tennessee may modify, suspend or revoke this authorization or seek modification or revocation should the state determine that the activity results in more than an insignificant violation of applicable water quality standards or violation of the TWQCA. Failure to comply with permit terms may result in penalty in accordance with T.C.A. §69-3-115.
