NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Proposed Issuance of NPDES Permit

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN; the Division of Water Resources will hold the following public hearing pursuant to Rule 0400-40-05-.06 (8) of the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation.

The public hearing will be presented via video-teleconference and may be attended online, by phone, or in-person at the address above. Information describing how to join online or by phone is provided below. The Division will hold a preliminary technical session with the public from 5:00-6:00 p.m. for discussion and review of the permit application and plans. The formal public hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. At the hearing, the Division will receive public comments concerning the proposed issuance of an NPDES permit to the following applicant:

The application and draft permit are available on the Division's Data Viewer at <u>http://environment-online.state.tn.us:8080/pls/enf reports/f?p=9034:34001</u>. This is a proposed new NPDES permit for a limestone quarry and processing facility located at latitude 36.3170 and longitude -87.5557. The facility consists of 55.3 acres. The receiving stream for the proposed discharge is an unnamed tributary to Yellow Creek (Indian Branch). The public hearing is being held by TDEC in response to interest and concerns within the local community about the proposed site. The purpose of the hearing is to gather information from the public relevant to a final decision on the permit application. Comments not related to water quality or to the information contained in the permit application will not be considered in the NPDES decision-making process. Issues such as air quality, zoning, blasting, noise, dust, and traffic are not related to water quality and are not regulated by the Division of Water Resources or the NPDES program; therefore, consideration of these issues would not contribute relevant information for the proposed NPDES permit.

The hearing officer may limit the length of oral comments to five minutes and will require that all comments be relevant to NPDES water quality-related issues. Undue repetition in oral presentations should be avoided so that all interested parties will have an opportunity to present their concerns. Written comments related to the NPDES permit will be accepted at the hearing and at TDEC until **July 2, 2021**. Written comments will be afforded the same consideration as verbal testimony.

The public hearing will be presented online through a Microsoft Teams meeting. Participants may join online using the website link below or call in by phone (audio only). Participants are highly encouraged to join online to view maps, pictures, and other content that will be shared by the Division. Prior to opening the formal public hearing, an informational session will be held at 5:00 p.m. CDT. The videoconference will open to participants at 4:45 p.m. The informational session will allow participants to ask questions informally and receive input from TDEC staff. The formal hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. Once the formal public hearing begins, the question and answer format will end, and all public comments will be collected for the hearing record without response from TDEC during the hearing.
