The Division of Water Resources has reviewed the submitted documents to receive coverage under the Biosolids General Permit on behalf of Centerville Wastewater Treatment Plant. Coverage under the 2014 General Permit expired on April 30, 2019 and was administratively extended until August 15, 2019, when the new permit was reissued. If your facility would like to continue land applying non-exceptional quality biosolids in the state of Tennessee, please submit most recent lab results for metals, fecal coliform geometric mean, PCB/TCLP, and an updated agronomic loading rate calculation.
